Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner made a representation dated 4.02.2020 before the Chairman, District Primary School Council, Purba Medinipur being the respondent no.7 but such application has not been considered by the Chairman, District Primary School Council, Purba Medinipur till date.

Mr. Mishra, learned Counsel appearing for the Council is present.

Heard both the parties.

As the representation dated 4th February, 2020 is still pending, I request the Chairman, District Primary School Council, Purba Medinipur being the respondent no.7 to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 4th February, 2020 at page 156 of the writ petition and pass a reasoned order, as early as possible, preferably within a period of twelve weeks from date after giving an opportunity of hearing and to allow the petitioner to produce necessary documents at the time of hearing. The Chairman, District Primary School Council,

Purba Medinipur is also requested to communicate such decision at an earliest.

Learned Advocate-on-record of the petitioner is also requested to serve a copy of this writ petition to the Chairman, District Primary School Council, Purba Medinipur along with the order of this Court positively within 7 days from today.

The writ petition being WPA 5836 of 2021 is accordingly disposed of.

I make it clear that I have not gone into the merits of the writ petition, all the issues are left open to the Chairman, District Primary School Council, Purba Medinipur to be decided by him.

There will be no order as to costs.

Since no affidavits have been invited, the allegations made in the writ petition are deemed to have been denied.
