This is an application under Article 226 of the Constitution of India wherein the writ petitioner is aggrieved by non-consideration of his representation dated February 06, 2020 by the State Transport Authority, being the respondent No. 2.

Affidavit-of-service filed in Court today be kept with the record.

I have heard learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the parties and perused the materials placed on record. I am of the view that the representation of the petitioner is required to be considered by the concerned respondent.

In the light of the above, I direct the respondent No. 2 to consider the representation dated February 06, 2020 made by the petitioner upon granting an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, and thereafter, pass necessary reasoned order within a period of four weeks from the date of communication of this order.

Petitioner is given liberty to communicate the order passed in Court today along with a copy of this writ petition upon the respondent No. 2 forthwith.

The reasoned order should be communicated to petitioner within a week from the date of passing such

reasoned order.

With the aforesaid observation, the writ petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

Since, no affidavit-in-opposition has been called for, the allegations made in the writ petition are deemed to have not been admitted by the respondents.
