This is an application for expeditious disposal of N.D.P.S. Case No. 75/2018 under Sections 21(c)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 pending before the learned Judge, Special Court, Berhampore, Murshidabad.

It has been submitted by the learned advocate for the petitioner that out of nine witnesses, only three witnesses have been examined so far and thereafter, there has been no further progress in the case.
