This revisional application has been filed praying for expeditious disposal of Title Suit No.282 of 2008 pending before the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division) at Barasat. It appears that some interlocutory applications are also pending.

Under such circumstances, this revisional application is disposed of without going into the merits of the pending applications, with a direction upon the learned Court below to dispose of the interlocutory applications expeditiously, preferably within a period of three months from the next date fixed upon allowing the parties to contest the same. There will be, however, no order as to costs.
