Having heard the learned advocate for the petitioner this Court is of the view that the instant revision can be disposed of without service of notice upon the opposite party.

It is submitted by the learned advocate for the petitioner that the petitioner got a decree for divorce on 6th January, 2021 in Matrimonial Suit No.986 of 2016.
