All these three matters are taken up together as common question of law and facts are involved in these three matters.

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties.

Our attention is drawn to the order passed by a coordinate bench of this court on 13<sup>th</sup> August, 2014, whereby the Tribunal was requested to dispose of the original applications as expeditiously as possible.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that in spite of the order dated 13<sup>th</sup> August, 2014, no progress has been made towards the said applications.

All the writ petitions are thus disposed of without any order as to costs.
