Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Having heard learned advocates for the petitioner and the State and having considered the fact that the principal accused was granted anticipatory bail by the jurisdictional Court and having considered the fact that other co-accused were enlarged on bail and having considered the injury report under Section 161 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and having considered the fact that the police filed charge sheet, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that he

shall appear before the jurisdictional court on the dates fixed for trial and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail being C.R.M. 3323 of 2021 is, thus, disposed of.
