This is an application for expeditious disposal of the proceedings being NI Act 51/19 pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Court at Sealdah, 24-Parganas (South) under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that though the complainant has been examined, and the process has been issued, but till date the plea has not been recorded.

He prays for expeditious disposal of the proceedings.

In this pandemic situation, the delay in disposal of the trial cannot be attributed to the learned Magistrate.
