The Instant appeal is directed against the judgment and award dated November 19, 2014 passed by the learned Judge, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal & District Judge at Barasat, in M.A.C. Case No. 90 of 2014.

Mr. Jayanta Kumar Mandal, learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant/claimant submits that the matter has been settled with the Insurance Company and the Insurance Company is now required to pay an additional sum of Rs.5,00,000/- by way of enhancement. He further submits that he does not wish to pursue this appeal. It is further submitted that the awarded sum has already been paid to the claimant/appellant.

In the light of the above submission, the Insurance Company is directed to pay the enhanced sum of Rs.5,00,000/- to the claimant's bank account directly within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the bank account details of the appellant.

Learned Counsel for the appellant will forward the bank account details of the appellant within a fortnight from date to the learned Counsel for the Insurance Company.

With the aforesaid directions the instant appeal is disposed of.

There shall be no further order as to costs.
