It appears that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and the petitioners are not inclined to proceed with the case any further. Such contention of the petitioners has been verified to be true and correct.

Accordingly, petition for joint compromise/memorandum of understanding being CRAN 1 of 2019 (Old No. CRAN 584 of 2019) is allowed.
