transfer of the proceedings, I am of the opinion that the reasons for
which other proceedings have been transferred do not exactly apply
to the subject-matter of the present transfer petition which relates
to an appeal under Section 29 of the Protection of Women from
Domestic Violence Act, 2005.

January, 2022.

The learned appellate court would, in the fitness of
circumstances, take all efforts to dispose of the appeal on 28th
January, 2022 or within a period of sixty days thereafter.
