In re : An Application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed on 31.05.2021 in connection with Itahar Police Station Case No. 3 of 2021 dated 04.01.2021 under Sections 341/323/325/308/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the injury report.

Considering the fact that the police submitted charge-sheet and considering the nature of injury and the materials in the case diary, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date and with a further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional court on every date fixed for hearing.

The prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed.

CRM 3825 of 2021 is disposed of.
