Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are in-laws of the deceased husband. The petitioners were falsely implicated.

Learned advocate appearing for the State refers to the postmortem report.

Considering the materials in the case diary and considering the postmortem report, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the Court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date and on a further

condition that the petitioner no. 1 shall report to the Investigating Officer of the case once a month and petitioner no. 2 shall cooperate with the investigation of the case.

Prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

CRM 4145 of 2021 is **disposed of**.
