This is a revisional application for expeditious disposal of the proceedings being A.C.G.R. Case No. 410/2019 under Section 408 of the Indian Penal Code pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate, 6th Court at Alipore.

It has been submitted by the learned advocate for the petitioner that after taking cognizance in this case, learned Magistrate could not proceed with the trial. He further submits that there are four witnesses to be examined and the trial should be expedited.
