It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he has been falsely implicated in the instant case.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

We have considered the materials on record, including the injury report. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and the extent of complicity of the petitioner in the alleged crime, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before

the Court below and pray for regular bail within a period of four weeks from date.

This application for anticipatory bail is, thus, **allowed**.
