Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate for the petitioners submits that petitioners were falsely implicated in the instant case.

Learned advocate for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having considered materials in the case diary and bearing in mind the nature of allegations, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner no. 1 while on bail, shall meet the investigating officer once in a fortnight until further orders. Petitioner no. 2 shall co-operate with investigation in accordance with law. Petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application being CRM 4348 of 2021 is disposed of.
