When the matter is called on for hearing, learned counsel for the applicant, by relying on the lower court records, points out that there were two orders passed on the relevant date. By the first order, an application under Section 7(2) of the West Bengal Premises Tenancy Act was disposed of, whereas by the later order, it was recorded that an application with a prayer to withdraw the original tax token and blue books (registration card) of three cars as exhibited on that date had been made and was kept on record.

As such, from the records, it appears *prima facie* that the certified copies of both orders, respectively annexed to the revisional application and to the recall application, were valid and are borne out by the records also.
