Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate for the petitioners submits that the husband was granted bail by the jurisdictional court.

State is represented.

Considering the materials in the case diary and considering the fact that husband was granted bail, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner no. 2 while on bail, shall meet the investigating officer once in a month until further orders. Petitioner nos. 1 and 3 shall co-operate with investigation in accordance with law. Petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application being CRM 4568 of 2021 is disposed of.
