Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the police complaint is a result of counter blast to land dispute.

We have heard learned Advocate for the State. Considering the material in the case diary and considering the fact that the defacto complainant refused to undergo medical test and there are disputes between the private parties, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date and with a further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer once in a month.

The prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed.

CRM 4799 of 2021 is disposed of.
