Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were falsely implicated.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the contents in the case diary. In answer to a query from the Court, learned Advocate appearing for the State submits that the police submitted charge sheet.

Considering the fact that the police submitted charge sheet and considering the gravity of the allegations, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that they shall appear before the jurisdictional Court on the dates fixed for

trial and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail being C.R.M. 4888 of 2021 is, thus, disposed of.
