This appeal has been preferred against the order of the learned single Judge dated 12th July, 2021 passed in WPA 10696 of 2021 whereby the prayer made by the learned counsel for the appellant to grant interim protection has been declined.

Learned counsel for the parties do not dispute that in the meanwhile respondent has filed the affidavit-in-opposition and the matter is ripe for hearing and in fact it is already included in the hearing list. A joint submission has been made by learned counsel for the parties that the interest of justice will be served, if the main matter itself is heard expeditiously.

Hence, we dispose of this appeal granting liberty to the parties to make a request to the concerned learned single Judge for taking up the petition for hearing on an early date.

We express hope that having regard to the nature of controversy involved in the matter, the prayer made by learned counsel for the parties will be duly considered.

Accordingly, the appeal along with connected application is disposed of.
