Petitioner renews the prayer for bail.

This is the 4th attempt to obtain bail. There is hardly any change in circumstance subsequent to the last order of refusing to grant bail to the petitioner.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner seeks expeditious disposal of the trial.

Since there is hardly any change in circumstances since the last order of rejection of bail, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.
