Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the de facto complainant and the petitioner entered into a compromise. She seeks bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the injury report. She submits that the police filed charge sheet.

De facto complainant is represented.

Considering that the police completed the investigation and submitted charge sheet, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction

of the Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ranaghat, Nadia subject to condition that the petitioner shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event, the petitioner fails to appear before the trial court without any justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel the bail of the petitioner in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for bail is **allowed**.

CRM 5037 of 2021 is **disposed of**.
