Case No. **550 of 2020** dated **17/11/2020** under Sections **498A/304B/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and corresponding G.R. Case No.7202 of 2020.

Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the husband was enlarged on bail. The police submitted charge sheet. Therefore, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the contents in the case diary.

Considering the materials in the case diary and considering the fact that the police submitted charge sheet and considering the fact that the husband was enlarged on bail by the jurisdictional Court, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the

satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that she shall appear before the jurisdictional Court on the dates fixed for trial and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail being C.R.M. 5148 of 2021 is, thus, disposed of.
