This is an application for expeditious hearing of N.D.P.S case no. 136 of 2020 under Sections 21(C)/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, pending before the Court of the learned Judge, Special Court cum Additional Sessions Judge, 5th Court, Berhampore, Murshidabad.
