The petitioner prays for expeditious hearing of NDPS case no. 264 of 2018 under Sections 21(C) /29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, pending before the learned Additional Session Judge, 2nd Court at Berhampore, Murshidabad.

It has been submitted by the learned advocate for the petitioner, that the petitioner is in custody for three years. It has also been submitted that though the schedule of evidence was fixed on four occasions, till date no evidence has been recorded.

In this pandemic situation, it is not expected of the learned Judge in the Court below to conduct the trial with normal pace.
