Records of the revisional application reflect that the  
matter appeared on 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2012, 2<sup>nd</sup> August, 2012 and 4<sup>th</sup>  
October, 2012 and the revisional application is yet to be admitted.

The subject-matter of the revisional application relates to  
an order dated 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2012 passed by the learned Judicial  
Magistrate, 1<sup>st</sup> Court, Howrah in connection with Complaint Case  
No. 1155C of 2008 under the Sections 449/323/354/506/34 of the  
Indian Penal Code.

I have perused the order passed by the learned  
Magistrate and I find that the reasons which have been assigned for  
dismissal in respect of the contention advanced by the petitioner are

Accordingly, CRR 1825 of 2012 is dismissed.
