It is the case of the petitioner that the learned Additional Sessions Judge in the Court below, after the commitment of the case by the learned Magistrate, could not frame the charge till date.

Ms. Sukanya Bhattacharyya, learned advocate for the State, submits that September 7, 2021, has been fixed for framing of charge against the petitioner.
