Thirty-seven petitioners have joined in this writ petition having identical but independent causes of action. Court fees have been put in respect of one petitioner only.

Deficit court fees shall be put in within next week, failing which this writ petition shall not be maintainable at the instance of the petitioners no. 2 to 37.

The learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the present writ petition has been preferred challenging the selection process pertaining to the 1st State Level Selection Test, 2016 pursuant to the notification dated 23rd September, 2016 for recruitment to the post of Assistant Teachers in Upper Primary Schools in the State of West Bengal.

By a judgment delivered on 11th December, 2020 in similar matters, a coordinate Bench of this Court has set aside and cancelled the selection process for appointment of candidates to the post of Assistant Teachers of Upper Primary Schools in the State of West Bengal.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed in the present writ petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of.

Since no affidavit-in-opposition is called for, allegations made in the writ petition are deemed not to have been admitted.
