The revisional application was preferred challenging the proceedings relating to C. R. Case No. 386/2011 filed under Section 406 of the Indian Penal Code pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate, 2nd Court, Siliguri, Darjeeling.

Record of this revisional application reflects that the interim order passed earlier was upto 31st August, 2013 and the same has never been extended thereafter.

Today when the matter has been called on, none appeared on behalf of the petitioners to inform this court regarding the present stage of the proceedings before the learned court.
