In re : An Application for **anticipatory bail** under Section **438** of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Nabadwip** Police Station Case No. **125** of **2021** dated **05.04.2021** under Sections **498A/326/307/34** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and under Sections **3 and 4** of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 and charge sheet submitted under Sections 498A/302/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and under Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was falsely implicated.

Learned advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the contents in the case diary including the statements recorded under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code.

Considering the nature of the offences and considering the complicity of the petitioner therein and considering the fact that police submitted charge sheet, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties

of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the Court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional Court on every date fixed for hearing.

Prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

CRM 5845 of 2021 is **disposed of**.
