This is an application for expeditious disposal of complaint case no. CNS/24 of 2018 before the learned Metropolitan Magistrate, 16th Court at Kolkata.

It has been submitted by Mr. Ajay Chaubey, learned advocate for the petitioner, that the case is at the evidence stage, and the hearing of the case has been adjourned by the learned Magistrate in the Court below on several occasions, causing serious prejudice to the petitioner.
