Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that there was incident with regard to politics.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners subscribe to a political ideology. The petitioner no. 4 also sustained injury. The first information report was lodged 90 days after the incident.

Learned advocate for the State draws the attention to the injury report and the statements recorded under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the injury report and the statement recorded under section 164 of the Cr.P.C. we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the Petitioners shall meet the Investigation Officer once in a week until further orders and that the petitioners shall appear before the Court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

Prayer for anticipatory bail is, thus, **allowed**.
