In re : An Application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed on 02.09.2021 in connection with Pukhuria Police Station Case No. 285 of 2021 dated 01.08.2021 under Sections 341/323/325/326/307/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Having heard the learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners and the State and having considered the gravity of the offences and the complicity of the petitioners therein, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and with a further condition that the petitioner nos. 1 and 4 shall meet the Investigating Officer once in a month till the conclusion of the investigation and petitioner nos. 2 and 3 shall cooperate with the investigation and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the Court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed.

CRM 5927 of 2021 is disposed of.
