This is an application for expeditious hearing of the case bearing No. G.R. 6127 of 2016 under Sections 420/120B/468/471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate, 4th Court, Barrackpore.

The petitioner before this Court is the husband of the opposite party no. 1, who is the de-facto complainant.

It has been submitted by the petitioner, who appears in person, that after the cognizance was taken, the case was transferred to the 4th Court of the learned Judicial Magistrate at Barrackpore on April 18, 2018, but the charge hearing has not yet taken place.

Keeping in mind the innocuous nature of the prayer, this application is disposed of with a direction upon the learned Judicial Magistrate, 4th Court, Barrackpore, to make an

endeavour to conclude the charge hearing within a period of three weeks from date.

Since this order will not prejudice the opposite party no. 1, the revisional application is disposed of without serving any notice to her.

The revisional application being **C.R.R. 1777 of 2021** is, thus, disposed of.
