Mr. Mirza Ahmed Begg, learned advocate, is directed to appear for the State, in this case.

Let the appointment of Mr. Mirza Ahmed Begg be regularized.

This is an application for expeditious hearing of the criminal case being N-102/2019 under Section 21 (c) of the NDPS Act, 1985, pending before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, 6<sup>th</sup> Court, Barasat, North 24 Parganas.

It has been submitted by the learned advocate for the petitioner that the case is at the evidence stage. There are total seven witnesses to be examined.

In this pandemic situation, the delay, if any, in conducting the trial cannot be attributed to the learned Judge in the Court below.
