In re : An Application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed on 03.09.2021 in connection with Nalhati Police Station Case No. 302 of 2021 dated 29.08.2021 under Sections 143/326/307/506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Having heard the learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners and the State and having considered the materials in the case diary, the gravity of the offences and the complicity of the petitioners, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and with a further condition that the petitioner nos. 1 to 4 shall meet the Investigating Officer once in a month till the conclusion of the investigation and petitioner nos. 5 to 8 shall cooperate with the investigation and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the Court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed.

CRM 5952 of 2021 is disposed of.
