None appears on behalf of the opposite parties in spite
of service.

The petitioners are the plaintiffs of the connected suit
for partition being Title Suit No. 84 of 2017 pending before
the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division) at Uluberia, District
: Howrah.

The petitioners are complaining inordinate delay in
disposal of the application filed by them under Order XXXIX
Rules 1 and 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure and are praying
for a direction upon the learned Trial Judge for expeditious
disposal of it.

Records speak that the said application for injunction
was filed way back on March 20, 2017. The application
under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 of the Code by its nature
demands expeditious disposal.

Mr. Tanmoy Mukherjee, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, submits that all the defendants have already entered appearance in the suit.

The learned Trial Judge is requested to dispose of the said application for injunction as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of two effective available working months of the said Court from the date of communication of this order and in doing so shall not grant any unnecessary adjournment to either of the parties.

CO 1599 of 2021 is thus disposed of without any order as to costs.
