Md. Kutubuddin, learned advocate, who generally appears for the State, is requested to appear in this matter. Let his appointment be regularized.

This is an application for expeditious hearing of G.R. Case No. 1604 of 2019 pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate, 5th Court, Serampore, Hooghly, under Sections 341/323/504/506/354B/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

The petitioner is the accused in the said case.

It has been submitted by the learned advocate for the petitioner that the case record was transmitted to the Court of the learned Magistrate on December 4, 2019, and thereafter, in spite of fixing several dates for charge hearing, till date, the charge hearing has not taken place.

It is not expected from the learned Magistrate in the Court below to conduct the proceeding at a normal pace in this pandemic situation.
