Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody for 810 days.

Learned Counsel appearing for the State opposes prayer for bail.

Having considered the materials in the case diary prima facie disclosing involvement of the petitioner in the alleged possession of narcotic substance above commercial quantity i.e. 5.5 liters of Codeine Mixture and in view of statutory restrictions under Section 37 of the N.D.P.S. Act, we are not inclined to grant bail to him.

The application for bail is, thus, rejected.

Trial court is directed to frame the issue of charge within two months from the next date fixed for framing of charge without granting unnecessary adjourned to either of the parties.
