Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that, the name of the petitioner came from a co-accused. The petitioner is a migrant labour. He is residing at his ancestral house from where recovery was made.

Learned advocate appearing for the State submits that, the investigation is ongoing. The recovery was made from the house where the petitioner resides. The petitioner and his two brothers were involved in the crime.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that petitioner is a resident of the building from where the recovery was made and considering the fact that the person arrested is the brother of the petitioner, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is rejected and the application being CRM 6025 of 2021 is dismissed.
