This is an application for expeditious hearing of complaint case being C-2065 of 2012, pending before the learned Metropolitan Magistrate, 13th Court, Kolkata. It appears that the process has been issued, in this case, under Sections 323/420/120B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

It has been submitted by the learned advocate for the petitioner that the case is at the evidence stage and the next date is fixed for cross-examination of the P.W. No. 1. It has also been submitted that there are total five witnesses to be examined in the case.
