Md. Kutub Uddin, learned advocate, who generally appears for the State, is requested to appear in this matter. Let his appointment be regularized.

The petitioner seeks an expeditious hearing of the Case No. N – 159 of 2019, pending before the learned Additional Sessions Judge (Special Court under the N.D.P.S. Act, 1985) under Section 21(C) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

It has been submitted by the learned advocate for the petitioner that the charge has been framed in this case and though the date for the hearing was fixed, the hearing has not commenced till date.
