Ms. Jeenia Rudra, learned advocate, appearing for the petitioners, seeks expeditious hearing of G.R. Case No. 1061/2012 under Sections 498A/406/323 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, pending before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Durgapur.

It has been submitted by the learned advocate for the petitioners that the charge sheet, in this case, has been filed on August 30, 2012, and thereafter, the case was transferred to the learned Magistrate in the Court below.
