By filing the present revisional application, the petitioner has prayed for giving necessary direction to the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division), at Amta for expeditious disposal of Title Suit No. 12 of 2019. It has been alleged that the defendant has not been appearing before the Court below and avoiding the service. Learned Court below has failed to dispose of pending interlocutory application has been fixing the case for service return.

The learned Court below is requested to see the interlocutory application, if any, pending in the pending suit may be disposed of at the earliest.
