Petitioners seek bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are not related to the incident. In any event since the police submitted charge-sheet further detention of the petitioners are not required.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the five statements of eye witnesses recorded under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. She opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the statements of the five eye witnesses recorded under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure implicating the petitioners, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

CRM 6295 of 2021 is dismissed.
