

C.R.M. 6119 of 2021

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed on **15/09/2021** in connection with **Baruipur** P.S. Case No. **1398 of 2021** dated **11/08/2021** under Sections **341/325/506/34** of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the complaint is a result of a longstanding dispute relating to an immovable property. The de facto complainant is related to the petitioners.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the injury report.

Considering the injury report and the materials available in the case diary, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that they shall meet the Investigating Officer once in a week until further orders and that they shall appear before the jurisdictional Court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail being **C.R.M. 6119 of 2021** is, thus, disposed of.
