Petitioners seek bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the police submitted charge sheet and, therefore, further detention of the petitioners is not required. He submits that the incident is a fallout of long standing disputes and that there are cases and counter-cases amongst the private parties.

Learned advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the injury reports.

Considering the injury reports and considering the fact that the police submitted charge sheet, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties of like amount

each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Krishnagar, Nadia subject to condition that the petitioners shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event, the petitioners fails to appear before the trial court without any justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel the bail of the petitioners in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for bail is **allowed**.

CRM 6204 of 2021 is disposed of.
