Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate for the petitioner submits that petitioner was not present at the locale at the time of incident. The allegation that the petitioner tortured his mother is misplaced.

Learned advocate for the State draws the attention of this Court to the injury report.

Having considered materials in the case diary and bearing in mind the complicity of the petitioner in the alleged crime, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner while on bail, shall meet the investigating officer once in a fortnight until further orders. Petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application being CRM 6344 of 2021 is disposed of.
