Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was falsely implicated on the basis of the statement of the co-accused. The police submitted charge sheet.

Heard learned advocate for the State.

Considering the materials in the case diary, the complicity of the petitioner in the offences concerned and considering the fact that police submitted charge sheet, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the

Court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional Court on every date fixed for hearing.

Prayer for anticipatory bail is **allowed**.

CRM 6357 of 2021 is **disposed of**.
